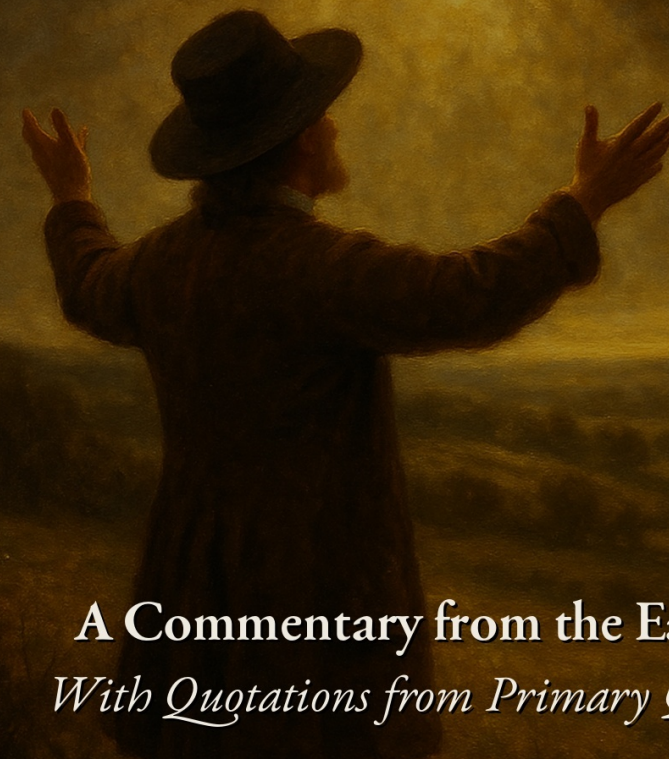

For three centuries the early Quakers—George Fox, Isaac Pennington, Robert Barclay, Edward Burrough, and many more—read the Gospel of John not as distant scholars but as people who had met the Light it proclaims. This commentary gathers their voices, chapter by chapter, drawing on more than 160 primary Quaker works to let the Friends speak for themselves.

Every chapter opens with the King James text, then turns to the testimony of those who staked their lives on “the true Light, which lighteth every man.” What emerges is not theory but witness—Christ known inwardly, Scripture read in the Spirit that gave it forth, and a faith of conviction rather than custom.
